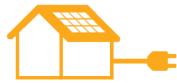

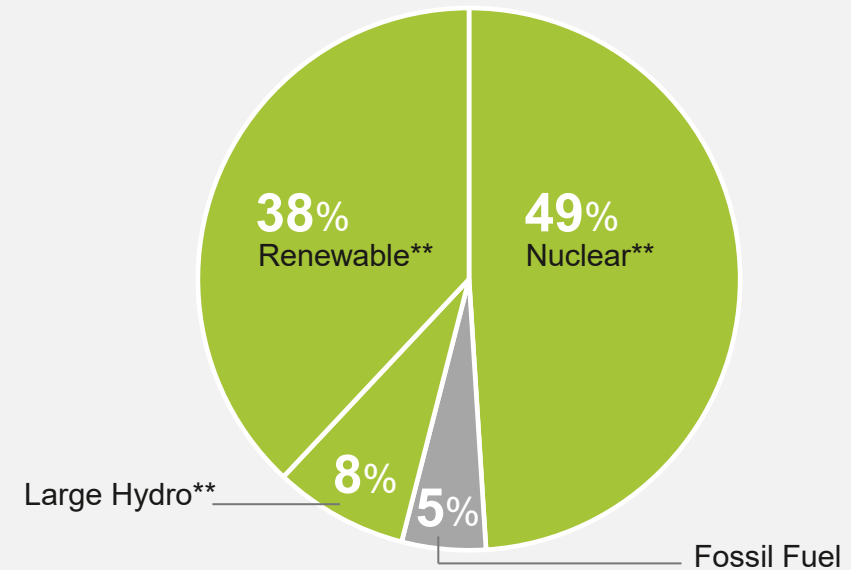

PG&E-owned generation and power purchases

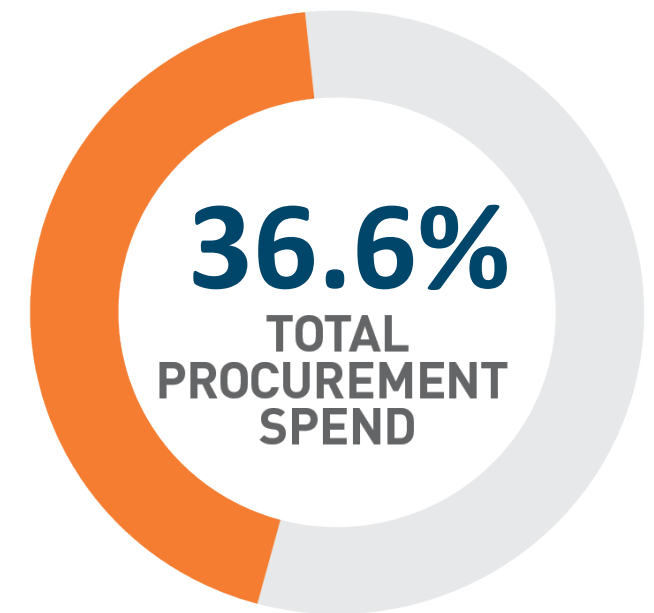
